TB testing (Mantoux Skin Test) for International Students is not publicly funded nor covered by Guard.me insurance therefore the cost is the responsibility of the student. Please note that for a 1 Step TB test it will require a total of 2 visits to the clinic to complete and 4 clinic visits total to complete the 2 Step TB testing process. More visits may be necessary depending on the outcome of the TB testing or if you require titre testing.

The walk in clinic accepts cash only for payment.

TB Reads must occur within a specific timeframe – no less than 48 hours after the injection but no later than 72 hours after the injection. A date and time will be given to you to come back for the read. A Step 2 Mantoux test cannot be done earlier than 7 days after the injection of Step 1, but no later than 21 days from the Step 1 injection. A date will be given to you to come back for the Step 2 test. (see below) Failure to have TB inoculums/reads during the specified window may incur additional costs to the student.

If you require titre testing you will need to go to Life Labs for bloodwork. There is a fee for this service which is approximately \$20 payable to Life Labs directly. Please go to their website to find a location: http://www.lifelabs.com/ You will receive a phone call when the results come in and given a date to follow up so please make sure the walk in clinic has the correct phone number for you. *Please note that the bloodwork for titre testing is sent to a Public Health Lab and will take 1-4 weeks to receive the results at the clinic.*

If a student requires a non-publicly funded vaccine, it has to be purchased through the pharmacy which is a separate fee and is the responsibility of the student, payable directly to the pharmacy. Injections for immunizations (after purchasing) are given in the clinic which is included in the \$70 visit fee if done on the same day as your visit. Purchasing the vaccine and having the injections done at a later date will incur additional costs so it is best to purchase the vaccine and have the injection on the same day as your visit.

Hep B – approximately \$25.00 per dose purchased at the pharmacy (visit fee not included) Varicella (Varilrix) – approximately \$66.00 per dose purchased at the pharmacy (visit fee not included)

If you require a chest x-ray you will need to go to Georgian Radiology. There is a fee for this service which is \$45.60 for 1 view and \$69.95 for a 2 view payable to Georgian Radiology directly. Please go to their website to find a location: http://www.georgianradiology.com/

How to make your clinic visits run smoothly:

- Come to the clinic on the specified dates and times for TB testing/immunizations for school
- Ensure you bring the correct documents
- Existing Immunization records must be translated into English
- Bring a translator with you if needed
- Be prepared to pay for services as above with cash payment
